

Kid's Peace Time

KPT is... Giving parents of young children peaceful time away from their "sheep" while giving gentle, Christian structured nurture to their children.

Dates: September through May

Days: KPT meets on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays. A child may come only **one** day a week. There are 30 sessions from September-May for each group. We are not a licensed program therefore we are restricted on the number of days we meet in a year.

Time: 9:30 – 2:00

Please arrive as close to 9:30 as possible and return for your child promptly at 2:00.

Ages: 14 months – pre-kindergarten

Fees: Yearly registration/Supply fee \$40/child or \$55/family (payable at registration time)

2018-19 Monthly fees \$68.00 - one child
\$120.00 - two children
\$150.00 - three (plus) children

Monthly tuition is due on the first attendance day of each month. Please talk to one of the directors if there is a problem in any particular month.

Scholarships are available for KPT. Please talk to a director at your discretion if you need partial assistance.



Daily Sign-in: Parents check in their children at the computers in the entry. Nametags are printed for each child with the parent's cell number and child's allergy information. A pick-up/release tag is also printed to be presented at pick-up time.

Withdrawals: Two weeks notice should be given to the directors in advance of withdrawal from the program. The directors reserve the right to cancel the enrollment of anyone who abuses the privileges and/or policies of KPT. The directors reserve the right to implement a probationary/cancellation policy for a child in the program if disruptive behavior persists. KPT wants to keep every child in our program and will work with the parents and child to deal with any problems that might occur.

Snacks: A beverage and small snack will be provided each day at approximately 10:30 am. Please list any food allergies on the personal information form. If you wish to bring a special birthday or holiday treat for your child's class, please make arrangements with the class teacher. All treats must be prepackaged or from a store bakery. Please keep in mind that we are a **peanut-free** program/church.

Weather Closings: KPT will follow District 196 (Rosemount, Eagan, Apple Valley) weather closings. If District 196 is closed or has a late start KPT will be closed. KPT staff will not be able to call everyone so please make it your responsibility to check school closings due to bad weather. If there is more than one full day closing you will receive a credit in tuition for one day at the end of the year.



What To Bring: BE SURE THAT EVERYTHING IS CLEARLY MARKED.

Yellow Ducks:

- Bottles or spill proof cups with water, juice or milk
- Finger food for lunch: include a beverage
- Disposable diapers, at least 3
- A complete change of clothing including socks
- A blanket or special comfort item for nap time

Red Rabbits/Brown Bears:

- Disposable diapers, if necessary.
- A complete change of clothing including socks
- A blanket or special comfort item for quiet time
- A well balanced lunch that is easy to eat and a beverage

Green Turtles/Green Frogs and Blue Whales:

- A well balanced lunch that is easy to eat and a beverage (no pop, please)
- Extra clothes- including socks and underwear (spills are sometimes unavoidable)
- If your child is not toilet trained, please have them wear pull-ups (bring extras along in their bags). We also ask that your child be in the process of training at home. These classes have two bathroom breaks and each child is asked to try to go to the bathroom each time.

What To Wear: Children should be comfortably dressed in play clothes. Play clothes are ideal since some crafts can get messy. Sneakers are the best footwear because of gym time. Clothing should be simple enough so the child can use the bathroom with minimal assistance

What Not to Bring: We ask that you do not allow your child to bring toys from home unless the teacher has requested them for a special activity. Please do not send party invitations or balloons to KPT.

Daily Routine: The classes are very structured. They consist of free play, snack, craft, story time, gym, movie, lunch, and quiet book time. The yellow ducks (14 months – 2 yrs) nap around 12:30. Each week we focus on a particular theme in which the craft, stories and activities coincide. At least once a month the theme will focus on a Bible story. We have a Thanksgiving Feast, Christmas program and a Mother's Day Tea. We have special weeks during the year including P-day (pizza, puff popcorn and PJ's), store day, and an egg hunt.
